#### **INTRODUCTION:**

This course is designed to offer candidates an opportunity to practice short case examinations. This will provide candidates with an excellent opportunity to see a variety short cases. There is high ratio of faculty and patients to delegates, allowing delegates plenty of time to discuss short case examination technique and common pitfalls.

The one day course is split into two halves:

- 1. The morning consists of small group teaching with a hands-on approach allowing candidates to see where mistakes can be made and how to develop a simple examination system suited to short case examination. The delegate will spend 10 minutes with each patient followed by a 5-minute feedback session. Each candidate will complete at least 10 stations.
- 2. The afternoon comprises two formal mock short case examinations designed to offer delegates a real life simulation of exam situations. There will be formal feedback to each delegate following the mock exam. Each delegate will see about 6 cases per practice examination. Small discussion groups will also hone examination skills by discussing tips and techniques with expert faculty.

The invited faculty will consist of consultants with experience in examinations and post-fellowship senior trainees.
